Balancing Rights & Protection: Relationships, Sexuality and Consent

Kim Marheine

Using an inclusive and person-centered approach, this session will enable a discussion of the balance of rights, self-determination, risk and consent when residents are at the center of relationships and decisions of risk. Complex scenarios will be discussed, such as when residents choose to have sex, when consent can be difficult to assess, and when staff or decision-makers might reach beyond boundaries and violate rights.

Objectives

- Participants will, through case examples, define aspects of assessing for consent to participate in sexual relationships.
- Participants will better understand the roles of staff and substitute decision-makers when restrictions on rights conflict with the expressed wishes of residents.
- Based on presentation information, participants will consider adopting for their long-term care settings "Guidelines for Consent," and will better understand the roles of staff in assessing for consent to participate in sexual relationships.
